From 1956, the vocation of the company Sarel is to develop, produce, and sell envelops for the physical protection and the installation of industrial automatism equipment, electrical distribution as well as VDI Networks. In 2011, Sarel joined Schneider Electric and became stronger on its markets. Historically Gema's customer, Sarel requested us to replace existing manual booths being technologically too old but

offering a greater application ease to the manual operators. The challenge was to maintain indeed improve the application comfort, plus to comply with the ATEX regulation and meanwhile to get a powder dust free environment.

To fulfill those requirements, the solution has been a **Magic Plus manual booth**, with two large lateral openings equipped with **2 lift platforms** and a **double OptiFlexs®2Q**.

The booth concept offers a comfortable manual application environment while the OptiFlexs®2 Q complied with a quick color change time and clean operation process. The entire installation upgrade with a proper ventilation, a new fire protection system and an up to date manual application offers to Sarel the ATEX regulation compliance and a full operator's acceptance.
